Is your partner or spouse cheating on you?

One of the most frequently asked questions of a private investigator is 'can you find out if my girlfriend / wife / boyfriend / husband / partner / spouse is cheating on me'. Often suspicions are aroused due to behavioral changes in a partner and it is unclear whether these changes are as innocent as they may claim. Potential signs of infidelity

- > They have become distant/ ignore you or become defensive when confronted
- > Distinct changes in mobile phone usage
- > They won't answer their phone around you or often if you call them, their phone is switched off
- > They work late more often than usual
- > They are very protective over computer history and their computer usage habit changes
- > Spending more time away from home
- > Their clothes have distinctive smells of perfume, aftershave, alcohol or smoke
- > They are not as interested in sex

These are just a few signs which may be reasons for you to suspect that your partner is being unfaithful.

Clearly some or all of these behavioral changes may be nothing more than pressure of work, financial problems or your partner taking an interest in their own appearance and looking to improve their lives with you, rather than without you, however when two or more of these signs are present it can often be that they are attracted to someone other than you. Catching your partner cheating is often quite difficult, particularly if you have a family as finding the time or resources to follow them without being seen is almost impossible.

Co-Habitation Evidence

When you separate or divorce from your partner and you have young children, either party has a responsibility to help with financial maintenance for the main carer who has custody of the children. However, if your ex-wife/husband meets a new spouse and they decide to live together, maintenance payments are affected and decreased due to increased financial circumstances.

What is Matrimonial Vehicle Tracking?

A GPS vehicle tracker is a small device that can be fitted to a vehicle discretely, allowing the movements of that vehicle to be tracked at all times. The device can detect the precise location of the vehicle at any time, including details of any stops and the length of time spent at each location.

The data can be tracked in real time so you know where the vehicle is at all times, and the sophisticated systems we use mean we can provide you with a report for any day or time, as necessary.
